POSITION SUMMARY:

Volunteers spend time with the children at Dunn House Shelter by playing games and doing arts and crafts etc. to give moms a break.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Good communication skills.
- Ability to develop active listening skills.
- Ability to develop understanding of domestic violence, oppression and related issues.
- Able to work in a high stress environment with diverse populations.
- Ability to assist in planning various children's activities (games, arts, craft's etc.)
- Must pass Criminal Background Check

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

- Interact with the children through play, games, art, crafts, reading, etc.
- Participate in support group involving children.
- Immediately contact a staff member should a child make an abuse disclosure.

SPECIFIC FUNCTIONS::

- Reports to Volunteer Coordinator and Children's Program Coordinator of Dunn House Shelter.
- Makes initial six month commitment doing a minimum of eight hours a month.
